Brick and Mortar Grant

St. Aidan's, Ann Arbor requested a \$1,495 grant to help fund a repair of cement steps. The cost will be split with the Northside Presbyterian Church of Ann Arbor who shares the property. St. Aidan's will be funding over half of their share of the repair. The total cost will be \$6,050. A motion was made to approve the committee's recommendation to approve a grant of \$1,495. Motion passed.

Brick and Mortar Loan

St. David's, Southfield has requested a loan of \$300,000 for use in a \$900,000 Capital improvement project. The loan request says "This project grew out of a Listening Campaign in 2014, to identify the improvements needed in the physical plant to better facilitate our use of the building for outreach and service to the community. The renovation in particular will upgrade the fellowship hall and foyer, completely renovate kitchen and bathrooms, make classroom space flexible, add air conditioning to the sanctuary and replace the flat roof over the fellowship hall, classrooms and offices." The committee turns this over to Diocesan Council for discussion and decision. Council requests that representatives of St. David's, Southfield return for the March meeting to answer questions regarding the project.
