The Special Convention to elect the IIth Bishop of the Diocese of Michigan will take place:

Saturday, June 1, 2019

The Cathedral Church of St. Paul 4800 Woodward Avenue, Detroit, MI 48201

<u>Schedule for the Day:</u> The Special Convention will convene at 9:30 a.m. A draft schedule for the day is enclosed. Registration will open at 8:00 a.m. in the gallery of the Cathedral Church of St. Paul.

<u>Lay Delegates:</u> Each congregation of the diocese is entitled to three (3) lay delegates and three (3) lay alternates. Packets will be mailed to each delegate on record in the diocesan office. If there are changes to your lay delegation, please report those changes to the diocesan office as soon as possible (<u>imichalak@edomi.org</u> or 313.833.4414).

<u>Clergy Eligible to Vote:</u> Clergy <u>both</u> canonically and actually residing in the Diocese of Michigan will be eligible to vote in the Special Convention. Clergy who are eligible to vote must contact the bishop's office to request permission to be excused from the Special Convention.

Registration/Credentials: A delegate or clergy registration/credential card is enclosed for members of convention eligible to vote. Please fill out the card and present it at the Special Convention Registration desk on June 1.

Seating at Convention: Voting clergy and voting lay delegates will sit together in a designated area. All other attendees for the Special Convention will be asked to sit in a visitor's section. This includes alternates, non-voting clergy and all observers and guests.

Convention Lunch Break: Delegates and visitors to convention are welcomed to reserve a boxed lunch for the mid-day break at the cost of \$12.00 each. A reservation form is enclosed in this packet, or you can reserve a lunch on the diocesan website at www.edomi.org/specialconvention/.

<u>Dispatch of Business:</u> A copy of the Dispatch of Business and Special Rules of Order for the convention are included in this packet. **Please note:** Our Canons do not provide for nominations from the floor.

GENERAL RULES OF ORDER

Each business session of the Convention will be opened with prayer.

According to Canon 1.3.2.6, the clergy and layperson Members of Convention shall vote separately, by orders. A_majority of votes of each order on the same ballot shall be necessary to elect.

After the ballots have been counted and the election completed, the Elections Commission shall prepare a written certificate to be signed by a majority of the Commission, indicating the number of ballots cast, the number disqualified, and the results of the election. The name of the person elected shall be announced by the Secretary of Convention, and entered in the minutes of the Convention.

The rules contained in the current edition of "Roberts Rules of Order-Newly Revised" shall govern the Convention in all cases to which they are applicable, and in which they are not inconsistent with the Constitution and Canons of The General Convention, or of the diocese, or the General Rules of Order of this Convention.

The President may recognize Points of Personal Privilege only during the time designated for announcements by the Secretary at the end of the last business session.


The Cathedral Church of St. Paul is located at the corner of Woodward Avenue and Warren Avenue in the Cultural Center. There is a parking lot behind the Cathedral. Entrance to parking lot is only from Warren Avenue via Cathedral Lane.

From north or south-bound I-75: Exit at Warren and proceed west four blocks to Woodward and Warren. The church is on the southeast corner.

From east or west-bound I-94: Use Woodward/John R exit, turn south on John R. (toward downtown) and proceed to Warren Avenue, turn right, get into left-hand lane and continue 3 I/2 blocks to cut-through on boulevard to Cathedral Lane.

East-bound I-96 (toward downtown): Exit at I-94 east and follow directions above.

Lodge Freeway (USI0): Exit at Forest/Warren. Proceed east on Forest to Woodward. At Woodward, turn left two blocks. Turn right on Warren, and right on Cathedral Lane. Church is on the corner of Woodward and Warren.
