OUR STORY

On Advent Sunday in 1956, a small group met at a home in Bloomfield Hills to discuss the establishment of an Episcopal mission. On a glorious Palm Sunday morning in 1961, the congregation marched the quarter-mile to their new church.

Our initial mission created by the founders of St. Stephen's continues to be carried on by today's families of St. Stephen's: a vital, warm, and giving parish. **Together They Did... Together We Will**.

As a congregation our commitment to our Mission remains strong. Despite the limited in-person worship, mission work and socializing last year, our pledges for 2021 were almost 20% higher than 2020. Our 2021 Operating Budget projects revenues of over \$300,000 and a \$20,000 surplus. Coupled with a Mission Development Fund of over \$100,000, over \$115,000 in designated funds and an Endowment Fund of about \$190,000, we are in a sound financial position.
