# Step 1 Appoint "Legacy Giving" leadership team

- 4-5 vestry, former wardens, patriarch/matriarchs
- Financial planners, estate planning attorneys
- Hospitality, party planning/event planning gifts
- Charge them with the remaining steps or calling us!

TIP - Have some actual LS members!

## Step 2 Decide on a name

- "[name of church] Legacy Society"
- Or alternatively, something personal or meaningful to your congregation, ex:
  - Society of the Rock (St. Peter's)
  - o The Booth Society (Christ Church Cranbrook)

**TIP** – Have someone create a logo to help in promotions

# **Step 4** Send an annual letter to congregation

- Announce/remind about the Legacy Society
- Invite them to consider leaving a gift
- Who to contact for help getting started
- Use it to share a story of impact, why it's important

TIP – Do it every year, 6 months-ish before your Recognition Event (Step 6)

# Step 5 Calendar an annual Recognition Event

- Chose a day that has some meaning to your congregation, ex:
  - o Founder's Day or date church was built
  - Feast day of your patron saint

TIP – Make it as automatic as Easter or Christmas; and make sure it's a 'good' date w/o conflicts

# **Step 6** Plan the Recognition Event

- Appropriate to the number of guests you expect
- Doesn't need to be fancy, but make it meaningful or fun
  - Legacy-themed Evensong and a reception
  - Dinner and a speaker
  - o Breakfast at Rector's House
  - Bus trip and a tour

TIP - They don't need to all come!

# **Step 7** Invite those who have self-identified to your Recognition Event


- Send private invitations to members of the LS
- Advertise <u>publicly</u> that the event is happening
  - o Promote in the newsletter/website/bulletin, etc.
  - Announce in your weekly services, post on FB, etc., etc.

**TIP** – Publicly promote but keep it members-only, i.e. don't make it a 'recruiting' event

# Step 9 Connect with an Estate Planning Attorney

- For people who need help getting started, have an estate planning attorney on hand
- Offer free consultation
- Will take people's call

**TIP** – Provide inquirers with basic the basic language the attorney might use.

- Guest speaker workshops

- Expand publicity

  Dedicated webpage, LS brochure, etc.
- Administrivia!

Undesignated gift policy, Create an endowment, Endowment policies, etc.

# Does this really work?

Church	Started with	Grew to*	How long?	# of PGS
St. Paul's Cathedral	20	125	7yrs	2
St. Barthomew's	-0-	55	2yrs	1
Christ Church Cranbrook	40	90	3yrs	-0-

- \$4-6 million in gifts in estimated gifts
- \$200k-\$300k in annual income (at a 5% draw)

# How does that work?

### For example:

- Average gift is \$25k
- 20 households

 $20 \times $25k = $500,000$ 

Yearly 5% draw = \$25k per year to your operating budget
