FORMATION PLAN: DIACONATE

The Bishop and the COM shall work with the Postulant or Candidate to develop and monitor a program of preparation that adheres to Canonical Guidelines outlined in Title III Canon 6 Section 5. This plan will include formal coursework, prior education and life experience; practical experience; and spiritual and emotional formation.

The areas of preparation are discussed fully in the "Formation Guide" and "Competencies for the Ordination Process" found at www.edomi/org/COM. The basic categories are given here.

CANONICAL AREAS OF PREPARATION

Portfolio: over the course of the period of formation, you will assemble a portfolio of artifacts that demonstrate your learning and work in these areas. Refer to Formation Guide for examples of artifacts.
