Summer Seminarian Expectations:

- The Seminarian will work for the congregation for ten weeks, including ten Sundays
- The seminarian will be supervised by the priest-in-charge or a priest member of a Total Ministry team
- The seminarian will be expected to participate in the leadership of Sunday worship weekly
- (i.e. part of the altar party); and preach on at least two Sundays during the internship
- The seminarian will work 20-25 hours a week for the congregation.
- The seminarian and supervisor will meet before the summer begins to develop three learning goals for the summer
- The Supervisor will commit to meeting with the seminarian for one-hour supervision meetings at least every other week
- The Supervisor will write an evaluation at the end of the summer, to be shared with the seminarian, bishop, diocesan field education coordinator and the Commision on Ministry
